Conference presentations are scheduled for 30 minutes each, with longer presentations available.

Guidelines for Submitting Abstracts

- Abstracts shall be a maximum of one-page, single-spaced and be submitted prior to the established deadline.
- Biological sketches of all authors shall be submitted and shall be a maximum of one page.
- All abstracts must be postmarked by **April 5, 2010**.
- Full presentations will be required for publication of the conference proceedings [PowerPoint presentations are acceptable].
- Abstracts should be mailed, faxed or emailed to Randy Warbington at the information shown below.
- Presentations are due at the conference.

Announcement of selected presentations will be made on **July 2, 2010**.

Further instructions for speaker preparation will be provided upon presentation's acceptance.
