- Sold to Johnny Morris (Bass Pro Shops Founder) in 1993




THE MILL'S REBIRTH

Preservation started with Engineering efforts to save the historic structure from the hungry flood waters of the Finley River.

#### FLOODING DILEMMA

- Planning started in 2016
- No detailed flood study
- Finished Floor below 100yr
- It has survived this long...
- Decided to raise building
- Save the Mill while meeting Building Codes























THE MILL'S REBIRTH

Conservationist: Johnny Morris, founder of Bass Pro Shops, had a vision to preserve the structure and share the property with the Community.






